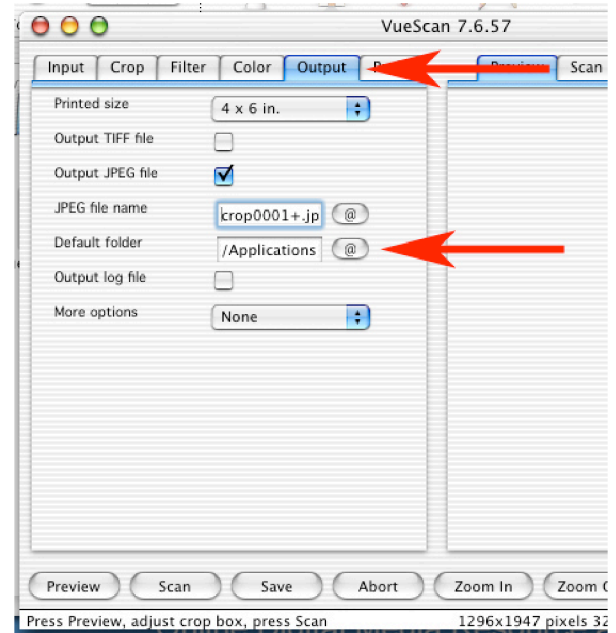


# Flim / Slide Scanner Guide

To start scanning, place your negative or slide into the slide scanner and launch VueScan. To find VueScan, use the following path  
Macintosh HD > Applications > VueScan

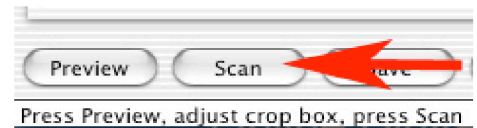


First, press the “Output” Tab on top of the VueScan window. Next press “@” button across from the “Default Folder” label to set the location of where your scanned files will be saved. We suggest you choose the “Desktop” to save your files, to avoid confusion of where you are saving your file(s).

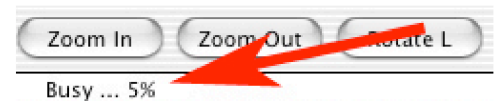


Next, press the “Scan” button at the bottom of the VueScan window.

**Note:** When you press the “Scan” button, VueScan automatically saves your file to the location that you established before. There is no need to press the “Save” button after the Scan has been completed.



**Note:** When scanning has begun, there will be no popup window indicating a scanning status. Instead, you will notice that the scanner progress is indicated under the “Zoom In” button at the bottom of the Vuescan window.



Once the scan is complete, you can either insert another negative or slide and begin the scanning process again or quit the Vuescan application.
